DISHWASHER JOB DESCRIPTION

The Kitchen department at Ballantyne Country Club (BCC) is currently interviewing candidates for a part time **Dishwasher**. This position is primarily responsible for the proper cleaning and sanitizing of all china, glassware, flatware, pots, pans and other equipment utensils, as well as maintaining a clean and safe working area. This position is located at our main clubhouse, where our dining area and golf course is located.

Essential Responsibilities:

- Ensures the cleanliness of every dish, pot, pan, piece of silverware, and glass that goes to the kitchen and our guests.
- Ensures the dish machine is operating at correct temperatures in all cycles.
- Ensures that the proper detergents (and levels of detergents) are being used in the dish machine and pot washing sinks.
- Ensures that the proper sanitizers are being used when cleaning walls, countertops, and floors.
- Maintains a waste management program in the dish area: controls unnecessary disposal of wrapped and/or unused crackers, Sweet n'Low, tea bags, creamers, jellies, knives, forks, spoons, ramekins, napkins, dishes, bowls, glasses, etc.
- Maintains a safe, clean, and organized walk ways in the kitchen.
- Assists kitchen with prep work during off peak hours.
- Ensures the dish area, kitchen floor, employee restrooms, employee break area, and storage areas are spotlessly cleaned at all times.
- Takes responsibility for the back dock and dumpster areas. Maintains these areas so that they are free from debris at all times, to prevent the unsanitary habitation of rodents.
- Performs his or her job duties thoroughly, to support the whole staff; and, must be fast, to keep up with our volume of business.
- Stacks and rinses dishes prior to running them through the dish machine for best results.
- Follows established procedures for proper flatware handling and washing for best, spot-free results.
- Disposes of trash and compact cardboard boxes as time allows and before the end of your shift.
- Puts away stock and clean other areas of the department as assigned.
- Restocks clean wares to their proper locations.

- Tuesday through Sunday, schedule varies from 8am – 2pm

Qualifications:

- Must be a team player, punctual, and reliable
- Must be able to regularly lift and/or move up to 50 pounds, and occasionally lift and/move more than 100 pounds
- Must be authorized to work in the United States
